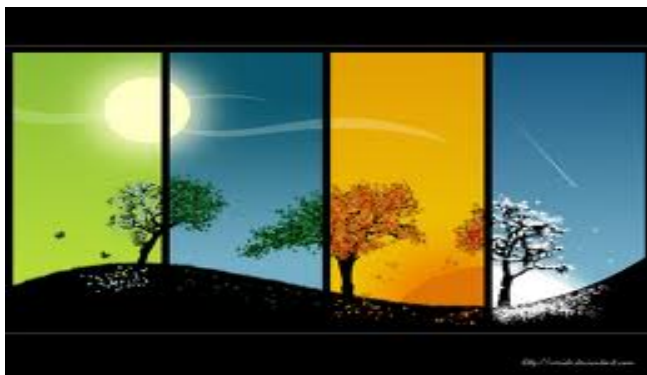

GOD WITH ME IN THE SEASONS OF LIFE

This month we will begin a new Sunday morning series of messages launched from the book of Ecclesiastes. Ecclesiastes 3:1 says: "There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under heaven." There are seasons of life we all go through emotionally, relationally, physically, and spiritually. Below is an overview of the eight-part series that will show you where we're going. I'm looking forward to teaching this series to you and walking with you through the varied seasons of life.

October 9 - Understanding the Seasons of Life. The seasons of life include both good and bad times but God will always be there with me.

October 16 - The Season of Difficulties. A season of difficulties is an extended time in our lives when we are facing things that are hard to deal with or hard to understand.

October 23 - The Season of Doubt. When a disappointment or devastation happens in life, it can lead to a "faith crisis." We all have doubts but we do not have to be defeated by them.

October 30 - The Season of Temptation. We all struggle with temptation but God can help us deal successfully with temptations in our life.

November 6 - The Season of Waiting. In a season of waiting, the important question is not, "How long do I have to wait?" The important question is, "How am I going to wait?"

November 13 - The Season of Loss. When we face a season of loss in life, God wants to help us respond in right ways. Lessons we can learn from the life of Job.

November 20 - The Season of Financial Stress. God promises to help us out and see us through the financial seasons of our lives.

November 27 - The Season of Loneliness. What causes loneliness and what God does to help us through it.
