The Three Numbers We Won't Forget ... 9/11

I remember where I was when it happened, and I guess you do too. I was at work on Tuesday morning when around 9 AM we received a phone call to turn on the television. We had no cable but could still pick up one station -- Channel 10. Our staff gathered around the TV and watched an ominous, horrific, fearful scene from New York City. No one in the office spoke a word other than maybe an "Oh, no." There was a sense of fear, uncertainty, and a wondering of when and where was this all going to end?

Two hijacked planes had crashed into the Twin Towers of the World Trade Center in New York City killing 2,606 fellow Americans who were simply at work that day. A third airliner crashed into the Pentagon killing another 125 people. Hijackers directed the fourth plane (United Airlines Flight 93) toward Washington, D.C.; it is assumed they were targeting the White House. But the plane crashed in a field in rural

Pennsylvania after heroic passengers took control of the airliner... and 44 more Americans were now dead.

When the dust had settled ... literally ... from collapsed buildings and smoldering planes, there were 2,977 victims of terrorism ... which includes the additional loss of life from brave firefighters, courageous police officers, daring members of the Port Authority, and bold paramedics – the heroes of 9/11.

This month marks the tenth anniversary of the September 11th terrorist's attacks. Ten years later, people still remember 9/11 each time they take their shoes off in an airport and wait in a long line for a security check. People still remember 9/11 when they see an old movie with the World Trade Center towers in the background or a newer movie where the twin towers are missing. People still remember 9/11 when news is reported of military casualties in Iraq and Afghanistan.

At Northcliffe, along with our nation, we will be commemorating the 10th anniversary of 9/11 with

"Remembering 9/11" services at 9 & 10:30 AM. I will be sharing a special message on how God is with us in the 9/11's of life.

Additionally, that Sunday evening at 6 PM in the Worship Center, we will be showing the film "*The Cross and The Towers*." This film talks about what happened on September 11, but it also deals with the issue of human suffering. The film asks the very difficult question, "*Can there be hope in the midst of devastation?*" The answer is both powerful and comforting. The movie shows the story of seven individuals whose lives were changed forever, not only by the horrific day of September 11, but by the stunning symbol of hope – a cross – they found buried beneath the rubble of ground zero. Witness first hand accounts of this stunning story of hope.

This is a great opportunity for you to invite family, friends, and co-workers to attend this special day at Northcliffe. I believe all who attend will be touched in our time of national grieving and yet, people will leave with a reason to have hope... something everyone needs now more than ever.
