The Importance of One - John 1:43-49

43 The next day Jesus decided to leave for Galilee. Finding Philip, he said to him, "Follow me."

44 Philip, like Andrew and Peter, was from the town of Bethsaida.

45 Philip found Nathanael and told him, "We have found the one Moses wrote about in the Law, and about whom the prophets also wrote - Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph."

46 "Nazareth! Can anything good come from there?" Nathanael asked. "Come and see," said Philip.

47 When Jesus saw Nathanael approaching, he said of him, "Here is a true Israelite, in whom there is nothing false."

48 "How do you know me?" Nathanael asked. Jesus answered, "I saw you while you were still under the fig tree before Philip called you."

49 Then Nathanael declared, "Rabbi, you are the Son of God; you are the King of Israel."

God wants to use you to change people's lives and eternities, too.

Here are three reminders that can help us share the good news with others.

REMINDER #1 - The good news is news that not to share.

Mark 16:15: And then He told them, "Go into all the world and proclaim the Good News to everyone."

(1) We can have a life.

Colossians 2:13: "You were at one time spiritually dead because of your sins ... But God has now brought you to life with Christ. God forgave us all our sins."

2 Corinthians 5:17: "Anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!"

(3) We can have a life.

1 John 5:13: "I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life."

(2) **Do an "I care" prayer:** "*In just a moment we are going to thank God for our food. Is there anything we can pray for you about today?*"

(3) **Share a short and sweet greeting:** "*The Lord bless you with a good day.*"

◆ **A daily prayer:** "*Jesus, help me, in some way, point someone to you today.*"
